



Prof. Dong-Sing Wu

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Dong-Sing Wu received the Ph.D. degree in electrical engineering from National Sun Yat-Sen University, Taiwan in 1991. In 2021, he becomes the 8th president of National Chi Nan University, Taiwan and a chair professor with the Department of Applied Materials and Optoelectronic Engineering. Dr. Wu has contributed more than 410 SCI papers, 7 book chapters and over 150 patents in his fields of expertise. He has received the distinguished Research Awards from the National Science and Technology Council of Taiwan, in 2009 and 2023, respectively. His current research interests include wide-bandgap oxides, thin-film technology, IOT sensing, photonic devices and displays. Prof. Wu has been honored by the fellows of Institute of Physics (IOP), The Optical Society (Optica), The International Society for Optics and Photonics (SPIE), The Institution of Engineering and Technology (IET), The Australian Institute of Energy (AIE), Material Research Society of Taiwan (MRS-T) and The Thin Films Society (TFS).
